VC10 and hear Royal Connections

During this talk participants will learn more about one of the largest civil aircraft build in this county. From design and production to it's final days and all the glamour in between. The VC10 is on the grounds of the world's first purpose-built motor racing circuit, constructed at Weybridge, Surrey in 1907. Brooklands is the birthplace of British Motorsport and Aviation, home of Concorde and the site of many engineering and technological achievements throughout eight decades of the 20th century.



Gear sticks and Lipsticks





This talk celebrates the incredible stories of the women that raced and made a name for themselves at Brooklands during its 32-year reign and which now remains as one of the greatest motor sport arenas in the world. The rising stars of the time like Kay Petre, Gwenda Stewart, Violette Morris and Elsie 'Bill' Wisdom showed as much courage and skill as their male counterparts – often beating them in the process. From its inception in 1907 by Hugh and Ethel Locke King through the first world war and to 1939 when it eventually closed, Brooklands was the place where glamour and speed were part of everyday life.

Special archive film of the Ladies Society Race staged by Barbara Cartland along with profiles of Bertha Benz and her first epic car journey, Violet and Evelyn Cordery and the Guys Hospital charity race are included in this informal look through an important chapter in sporting history.
